THOUGHTS ON THE PLAY

#### from Suzy Sampson DIRECTOR of HISTORY BOYS

I have led Drama Workshops for Teenagers with Tim Bray Youth Theatre for some years now so when it came to choosing a play to direct for **Company** Theatre **The History Boys** was an easy choice. It's very rewarding working with young people and encouraging them in the arts and this play is a great vehicle for these eight talented young actors and



a wonderful opportunity for them to practice their craft alongside highly experienced actors. Directing *The History Boys* was not without its challenges - how does one keep the comedy in a play where the lead character behaves so badly without appearing to condone that behaviour? Thank goodness times have changed for the better since Alan Bennett wrote this play, presenting, as he did, one of the key elements of the story as something that the boys were resigned to putting up with; we chose to represent Hector as a deeply flawed individual whose heart was in the right place. Bennett used his own school experiences to help shape this play. The character of Posner, the younger gay student with a crush on one of his classmates was based on him and I found it fascinating to learn more about the playwright whose work I have admired ever since seeing Maggie Smith's magnificent performance with Bennett himself acting alongside her in his true account of *The Lady in the Van*.

I feel very lucky to have gathered such an amazing cast who portray their characters so astutely and a crew so dedicated to sorting all the finer details needed to bring this production to life. I hope you enjoy watching it as much as we have enjoyed creating it. Arohanui, *Suzy*

#### SUZY SAMPSON Director

Suzy trained at The London Academy of Performing Arts and the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art in London, the Stella Adler Academy in New York and TVI Studios in Los Angeles. Her one woman show *Shakespeare's Will* by Vern Thiessen was awarded Best Production in Hong Kong and has toured Prague, Auckland, Tauranga and Wellington. In 2015 Suzy established the highly acclaimed Outdoor Shakespeare in

the Bay and produced, directed, and acted in *A Midsummer Night's Dream* and *As You Like It* at Te Puna Quarry. In 2018 she produced and directed *Outdoor Oscar Wilde* at The Elms Te Papa in Tauranga. Ben Elton's play *Popcorn*, which she directed for Company Theatre in 2018, received the ACTT Theatre Awards for Outstanding Comedy. Suzy also co-produced and acted in Geoff Allen's play *Sexy Buddha* at The Pumphouse, Vic Theatre and Pitt Street Theatre and directed and produced *Skylight* by David Hare at The Pumphouse in 2020.

MEET THE CAST

#### DUNCAN PRESTON Hector

Duncan has been performing with Company since 2020, when he played his first schoolteacher, Gordon Macintosh, in '**Peninsula**' Since then, he has played Algernon in *The Importance of Being Earnest* at Pah Homestead, another man called Gordon in *Neville's Island* and has just finished *Jerusalem*, where he played Rooster's loyal friend Ginger. Duncan is looking forward to playing another teacher as it fits in nicely with his day job of being



a teacher. Having been born and brought up in Manchester, the accent isn't too much of a problem either.



## WALT BOWERS FLEMING

#### Irwin

Walt is passionate about the arts, about creating a story, retelling an experience, and spreading emotion. He has performed in *A Midsummer Night's Dream, Nua Sila* and *Waiting for Godot.* Walt adores the character *Irwin*, as the morality of certain ethics are brought into question, challenging him to create layers for a character at first appearing straightforward.



#### CHRIS SMITH Headmaster

Chris's foray into acting began 3 years ago as he retired from working for the terminally ungrateful. After several classes, being cast as Hopeful Christian, appearing for a year in Auckland's Bus Stops in a margarine advert, and, more latterly, as The Professor in *Jerusalem*, he now appears as The Headmaster who he models on several he met during the Bronze Age.

#### CHLOE SMITH Dorothy Lintott

Chlöe is a Performing Arts teacher for an Intermediate School in Auckland. Prior to this, she worked behind the scenes at TVNZ for the **Breakfast Show**. Her passion for drama has seen her land roles in various theatre shows at Rose Centre, Centre Stage and Torbay Theatre. Some of the shows she has performed in include **All My Sons**, **Deathtrap** and **A Streetcar Named Desire**.



She also directs an annual performance on stage at the Aotea Centre for NZ's biggest student drama show called **Showquest**.

Chloe is thrilled to play the role of *Dorothy Lintott* in *The History Boys* and has thoroughly enjoyed working with the director Suzy and the cast to bring this famous play to the stage.



# **JESSE PARK**

Dakin

Jesse attends Auckland Grammar and like the boys in the play, is in his final year of school. He has loved being part of the Company Theatre family and found it an honour to work with Suzy, an amazing Director, and such a talented cast and crew. Jesse has enjoyed many years of speech and drama training, attending competitions, and performing in theatre productions **Brainstorm** (2020), and the

combined St Cuthbert's and AGS show **Night with the Stars – A Broadway Revue** (2022). A highlight last year was competing in the National Young Performer Awards where he won the Audience Choice Award. Screen acting is another passion, where he's been cast in a number of projects for film and television. This year he will sit his Trinity diploma and it is his aspiration to continue developing his acting craft and keep performing.

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


